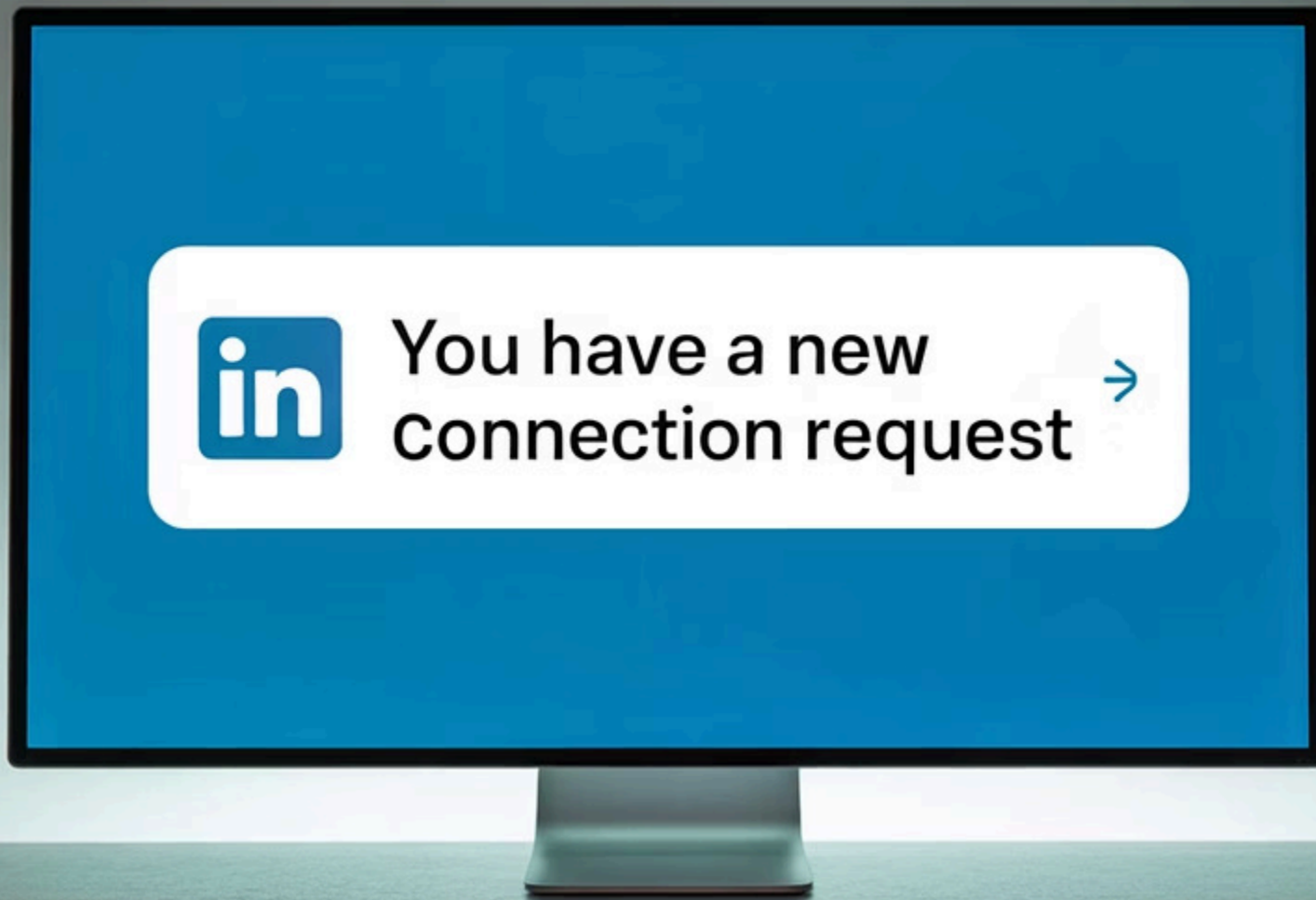




LinkedIn Just Updated Their Terms: Your Data Is Now Used to Train AI by Default

Did You See That Banner or Email?

- LinkedIn quietly changed its Terms & Conditions
- Starting November 3, 2025, your data is automatically used to train their AI models
- No opt-in needed — it's ON by default



What Does This Mean for You?

Your Profile Data

Profile info, posts, and public content help improve LinkedIn's AI systems

AI Features

LinkedIn uses this data to power job recommendations and content creation tools

Default Consent

Your data is being used without explicit consent unless you opt out



Why Should You Care?

Intellectual Property

Your professional insights and content are valuable intellectual property worth protecting

Privacy Control

Using your data without permission risks privacy and control over your own work

Professional Integrity

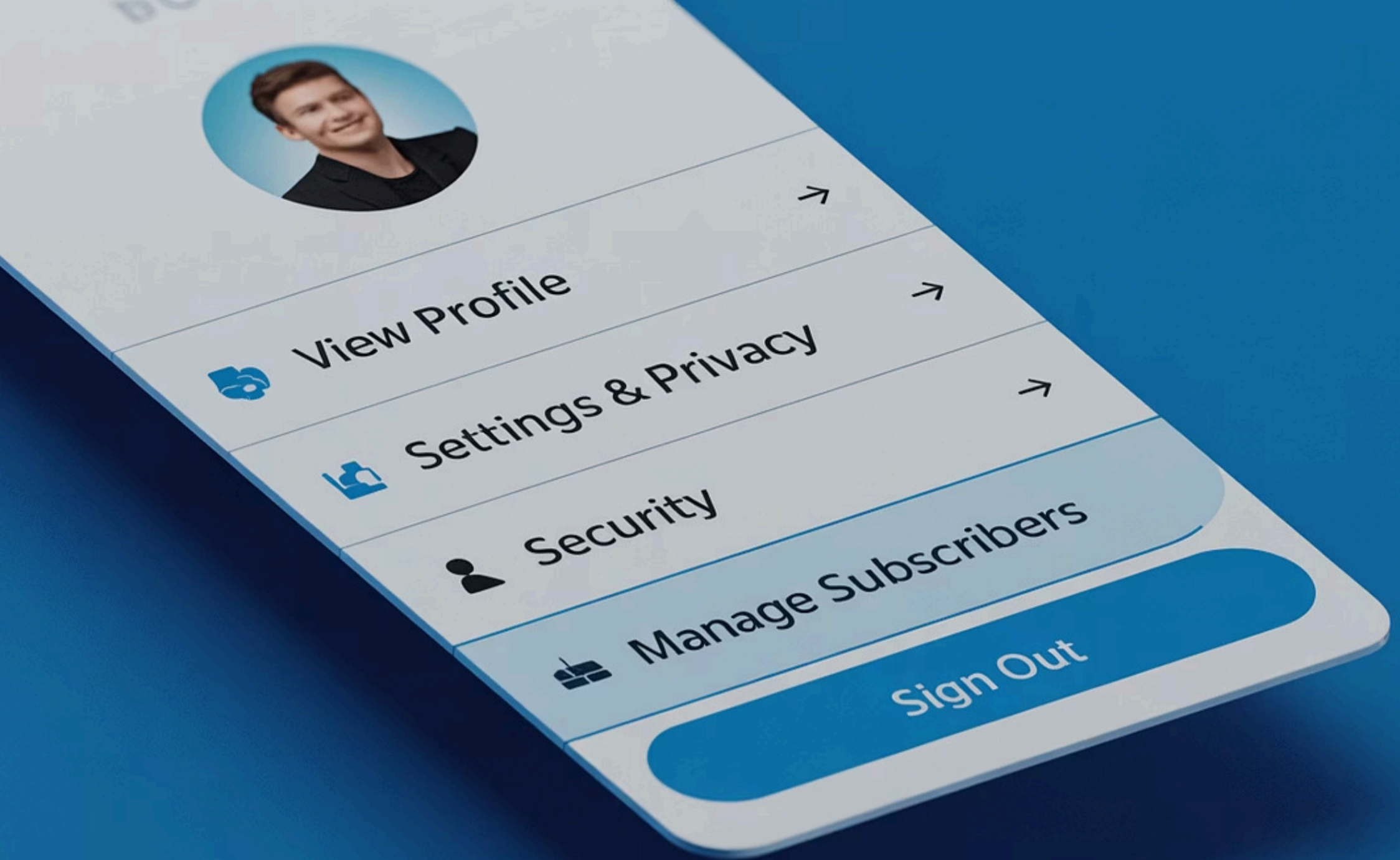
Opting out protects your digital footprint and professional integrity



How to Opt Out

in 3 Simple Steps

Follow this quick guide to protect your LinkedIn data from AI training.

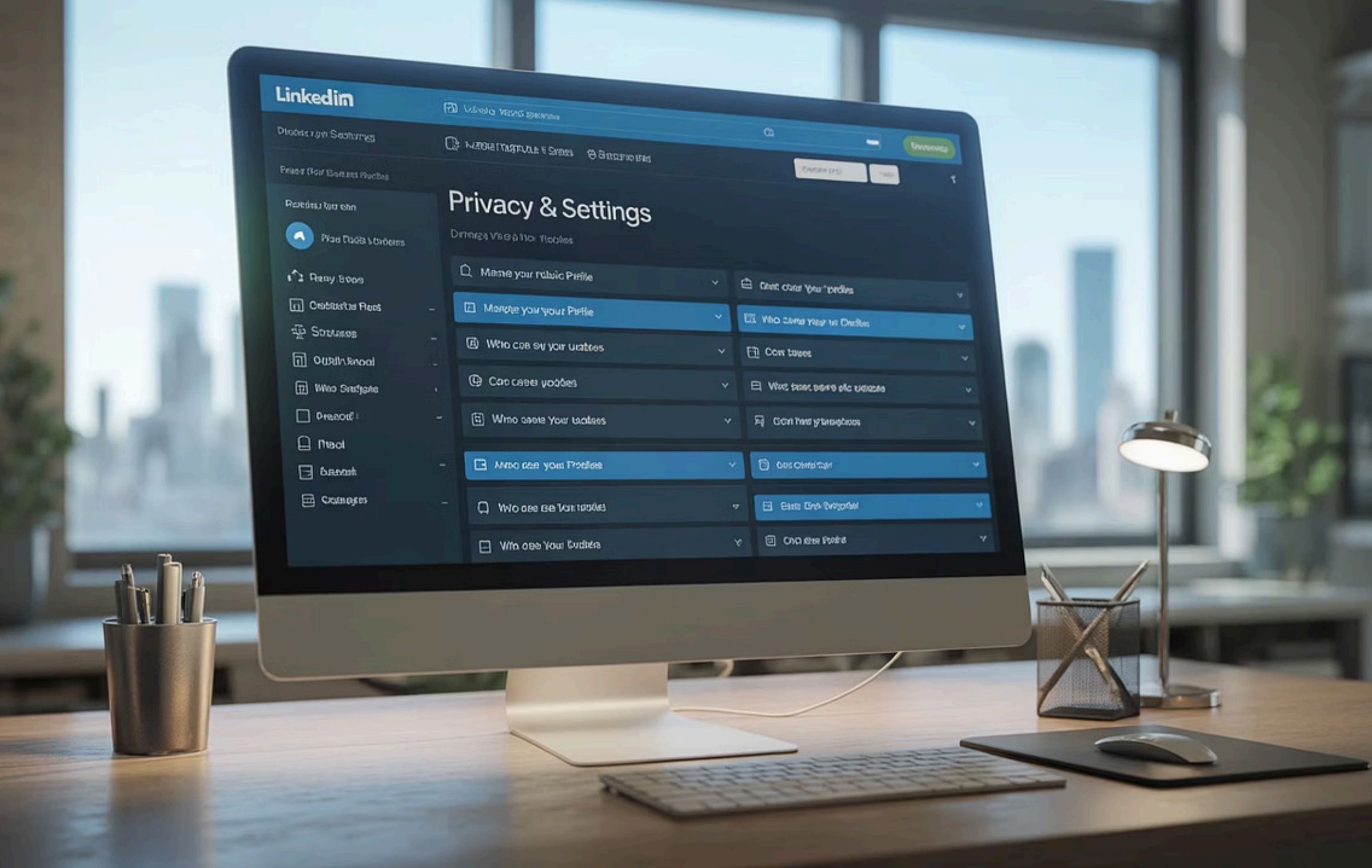

Go to Your Settings & Privacy

Click your profile picture in the top right corner

Select **Settings & Privacy** from the dropdown menu

Navigate to Data Privacy

In the left menu, click **Data Privacy**

Look for the section labeled Data for Generative AI Improvement

Toggle AI Data Use OFF

Switch the toggle from **ON** to **OFF**

This stops LinkedIn from using your data for AI training going forward

Past Data

Opting out won't erase data already used for training

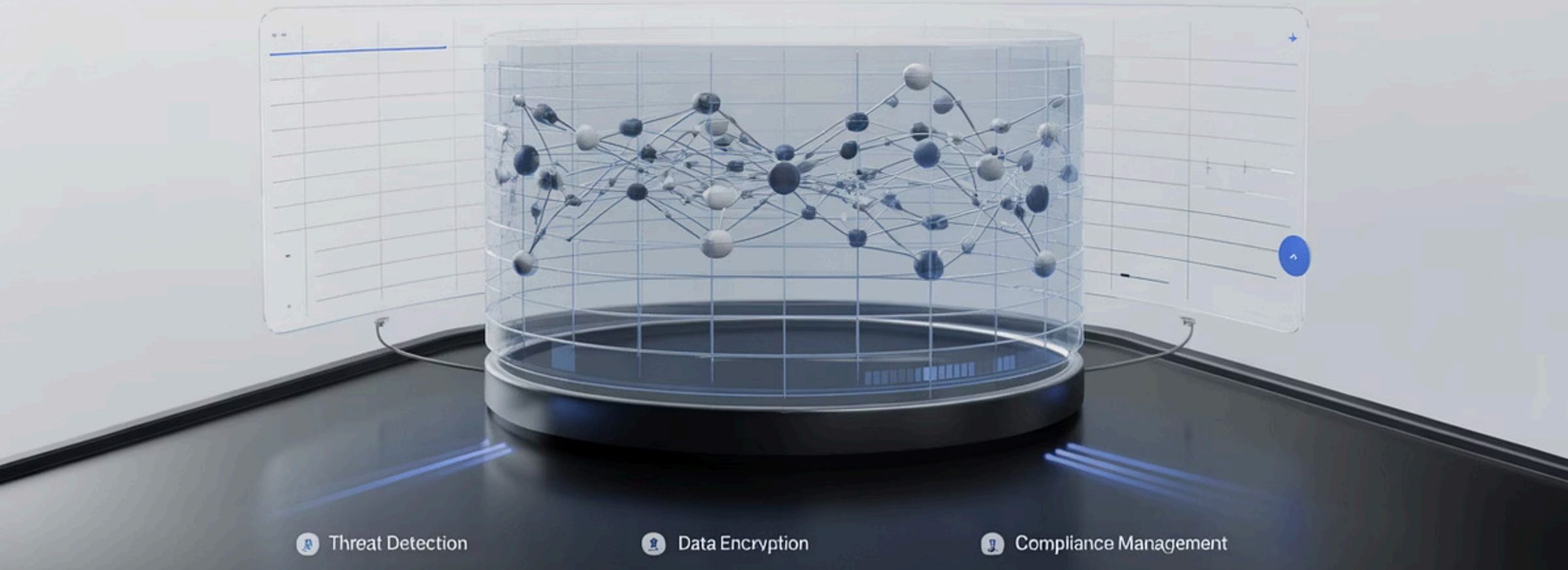
AI Features
